*Whether performing on American Idol, rousing participants at a Women On the Move luncheon or recording a song that stirs your soul, David Osmond has been inspiring people since his MS diagnosis in 2006.*

*"I thought music was done for me," David said. Earlier in his MS journey, he couldn't walk, his breathing was so labored that he couldn't sing, and playing guitar was impossible. Fortunately, he has regained much of his function, but thinks about what it must have meant for an Osmond to ponder a life without music.*

*David is the son of Alan Osmond, the founder of the famed troupe of singing brothers, who also lives with MS. David credits a favorite saying of his father's — "I may have MS but MS does not have me" — with helping him get back on stage."*

*Recent improvements in his health have allowed him to place his focus back on music. David was featured on the FOX hit TV show American Idol in 2009, David became his Uncle Donny's understudy in Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, and he reprised the role of JOSEPH at the CLO theater in Pittsburgh.*

*David has had some incredible highlights in his career as an entertainer, from performing onstage at Wembley Arena to singing at Harpo Studios for Oprah. He completed his debut solo album, REFLECTED, as well as his debut inspirational album, ROAD LESS TRAVELED, which was released in August, 2010*
